POP / PFOA Compliance Declaration

Legal requirements

The following regulations have been considered in the assessment of the confirmation, specifically Annex I, also known as the POP Regulation (persistent organic pollutants):

- Regulation (EC) No. 850/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 29 April 2004 on persistent organic pollutants and amending Directive 79/117/EEC.
- Regulation (EU) 2015/2030 of the European Council of 13 November 2015, amending Regulation (EC) No. 850/2004.
- Commission Regulation (EU) 2020/784 of 8 April 2020, amending Annex I of Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 of the European Parliament and of the Council.

These regulations contribute to the protection of human health and the environment, including the environmentally sound management and disposal of products or substances containing persistent organic pollutants (organic compounds). These organic compounds are toxic and highly resistant to environmental degradation. The regulations impose prohibitions and restrictions on the manufacturing and use of commercial products (such as pesticides and/or industrial chemicals) containing certain organic compounds.
